- Reproduction-slides, negatives and CD-ROM's from The Danish Jewish Museum remain the property of the museum.
- When publishing a publication containing photographic material from The Danish Jewish Museum, a copy of the publication or a special print hereof, must be given to the museum's library.
- Re-use of the material may not take place without explicit permission from The Danish Jewish Museum.
- Photographic material from The Danish Jewish Museum's collection may only be published on CD-ROM or on the internet in case it does not violate any copyright laws, and only in ways that are not offending to the artistic reputation or originality of the picture or object. It must be clearly stated, that the origin or provenance of the material is The Danish Jewish Museum.
